The Morris County Board of Taxation met at its office on 30 Schuyler Place, Morristown, New Jersey on April 18, 2019 at 10:00 A.M.

President Kersey presided and Commissioners Dr. DiFazio and Tyson were present. Commissioner Petracca was absent. President Kersey announced that proper and timely notice of the meeting had been posted and filed with the County Clerk, the Daily Record, the Star Ledger and The Record.

Also present: Kim Roggenkamp and Patty Marsh.

No one from the public was present. That portion of the meeting devoted to the public was closed.

On motion by Commissioner Dr. DiFazio seconded by Commissioner Tyson the minutes of February 21, 2019 were approved. On motion by Commissioner Dr. DiFazio seconded by Commissioner Tyson the minutes of March 7, 2019 were approved.

Business: The Board reviewed the annual reassessment application submitted by the Township of Long Hill for the tax year 2020. At the conclusion of their review, the application was unanimously approved.

The Board reviewed Regulated Criteria Reports for Revaluation for the following municipalities: Butler Borough, Chatham Borough, Madison Borough and Mt. Arlington Boro. After discussion the Board voted to invite the assessors from Butler Boro., Chatham Boro. and Mount Arlington to their June 20, 2019 meeting to discuss the need and time frame for a revaluation.

A discussion was held concerning the status of the ordered revaluation for the Town of Morristown. The Board voted to invite the assessor to their June 20, 2019 meeting to get an update on the progress of the ordered revaluation.

The Board reviewed and approved the tax appeal schedule for the month of May.

The Board approved the purchase of a tote bag item as well as a raffle basket to be donated to the annual NJ Association of County Tax Board's annual educational conference.

The Board approved attendance for office staff at the Northeast Regional Association of Assessing Officers educational conference being held in Rhode Island.

The following educational conferences were approved for attendance by Commissioners and staff:
Appraisal Institute July 22-24 in Denver Co., IAAO September 9-12 in Niagara Falls and NJ League of Municipalities November 19-22 in Atlantic City, NJ.

On resolution the Board went into closed session at 10:35 A.M. to discuss personnel issues. The closed session ended at 10:45 A.M. and the Board went back into an open session.
