The Morris County Board of Taxation met in its office at 30 Schuyler Place, Morristown , New Jersey on October 24, 2019 at 10:00 A. M.

President Dr. Michael DiFazio presided and Commissioner Tyson was present.

Also present: William Kersey, Administrator, Kim Roggenkamp and Patty Marsh.

President Dr. DiFazio announced that proper and timely notice of the meeting had been posted and filed with the County Clerk, the Daily Record the Star Ledger and The Record.

No one from the public was present. That portion of the meeting devoted to the public was closed.

On motion by Commissioner Tyson seconded by Commissioner Dr. DiFazio the minutes of September 19, 2019 were approved.

Business: The Board heard and rendered judgment on a tax appeal for the denial of a veteran deduction in the Township of Roxbury.

Glen Sherman, tax assessor for the Township of Randolph was present to discuss a Compliance Plan application that he submitted for the Board's approval. Mr. Sherman explained the need to adjust the 2020 assessment on 21 homes in the Township. On motion by Commissioner Tyson seconded by Commissioner Dr. DiFazio the Board approved the Compliance Plan as submitted by the Township of Randolph.

On motion by Commissioner Tyson seconded by Commissioner Dr. DiFazio the Board approved attendance at the following events: GIS Conference being held in Kentucky in March 2020, NJACTB Holiday Meeting on 12/6/19, Patricia Wright's retirement luncheon on 12/12/19 and reimbursement for Tax Assessor Mark Burek's hotel room at the Grand Hotel, Cape May during the NJACTB Educational Conference in August 2019.

The Board then met with a group of Morris County Tax Assessors to discuss policy and procedure.
