

The Morris County Board of Taxation met in the Freeholder's Public Meeting Room in the Administration and Records Building, Morristown, New Jersey on February 22, 2018 at 10:00 A.M.

President William Kersey presided. Commissioners Dr. DiFazio, and Tyson were present.

Commissioners Petracca and Steltzer were absent.

President Kersey announced that proper and timely notice of the meeting had been posted and filed with the County Clerk, the Daily Record, the Star Ledger and The Record.

Also present: Ralph T. Meloro, IV, Administrator and Patty Marsh.

No one from the public was present. That portion of the meeting devoted to the public was closed.

On motion by Commissioner Dr. DiFazio seconded by Commissioner Tyson the minutes of the Dec. 21, 2017 meeting were approved.

Business: The 2018 Preliminary Equalization Table was presented by the Tax Administrator, Ralph T. Meloro, IV, he announced that proper and timely notice had been posted and filed with the County Clerk in accordance with the "Sunshine Law", the Daily Record and the Star Ledger were notified via facsimile. Copies of the table were sent to each municipality, the assessor and clerk, the Director of the Division of Taxation, the County Treasurer, the County Administrator, the Freeholders and also posted in the public area of the Tax Board office. On motion by Commissioner Dr. DiFazio seconded by Commissioner Tyson the 2018 Preliminary Table was accepted

There being no objections to the Preliminary Table, on motion by Commissioner Dr. DiFazio seconded by Commissioner Tyson the Final 2018 Equalization Table was adopted as prepared by the Tax Administrator.

On motion by Commissioner Dr. DiFazio seconded by Commissioner Tyson the Board cancelled

their March 2018 meeting.

On motion by Commissioner Dr. DiFazio seconded by Commissioner Tyson the following educational seminars were approved for attendance by Commissioners, Tax Administrator and office staff: NJACTB Commissioners Conference, Mercer Community College 3/21/18, NRAAO Quincy, MA 4/28/18-5/4/18 and the NJACTB Annual Educational Conference, Cape May, NJ 8/26/18-8/31/18.

Commissioner Tyson inquired about revaluations and reassessments for the 2018 tax year. He was told that there were 6 reassessments and no revaluations.

Commissioner Kersey questioned whether or not East Hanover had provided an update concerning the status of their tax maps.

There being no further business, on motion the meeting adjourned at 10:30 A.M.
